Mohammed Al Kandari

Mohammed Ali Al-Kandari is a university professor specializing in Computer Science, as well as a photographer and creator of technical and humanitarian content. He is widely recognized for his humanitarian and relief efforts, having participated in numerous aid missions to refugee and displaced persons camps in Lebanon, Turkey, Jordan, Tanzania, Djibouti, Somalia, and Niger. He also played a key role in relief operations during the Turkey earthquake and the Gaza war, where he launched the "Gaza Resilience" campaign, raising over \$15 million in collaboration with the Kuwait Relief Society. His photography has received several prestigious awards, including the Hamdan bin Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum Award and the National Geographic Photography Award.
